Christos T. Papadas is an Associate Professor at the Department of Agricultural Economics and Rural Development, of the Agricultural University of Athens. He received his BSc in Economics in Jan. 1986 from the Economic University of Athens, and completed his graduate studies at the University of Minnesota (USA). He received his Master of Science (MSc) (July 1988) and his Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) (1994) degree in Agricultural and Applied Economics from the Department of Applied Economics at the University of Minnesota.

During his graduate studies he worked as a research assistant and researcher at the Department of Applied Economics, the Department of Rural Sociology, and the Center for Rural Sociology and Community Analysis, in the University of Minnesota. In 1994 he was appointed Lecturer at the Department of Agricultural and Food Economics of The Queen's University of Belfast (QUB). He was employed at QUB until 2001 where he taught also in an interdisciplinary post-graduate program in Rural Development at the Gibson Institute of Rural Studies. During the academic year 2000-2001 he taught also undergraduate and post-graduate courses at City College of Thessaloniki in academic programs of the University of Sheffield.

In 2001 he was appointed Lecturer at the Department of Agricultural Economics and Rural Development in the Agricultural University of Athens, where he subsequently became also Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, and Professor. He was also the Interim Chairman of the Department of Regional and Economic Development (Amfissa Campus) of the Agricultural University of Athens (2019-2022). He has taught courses in Agricultural Price Analysis, Applied Microeconomics in Agriculture, Investment Appraisal, Economics of Agricultural Development, Regional Economics and Development, and Urban Economics. He has supervised undergraduate and post-graduate theses, PhD dissertations, and he was also a member of similar supervisory committees.

Research papers of his have been published in refereed international academic journals, books, proceedings of academic conferences, etc. He has acted as referee in a large number of academic journals and he is also a member of several academic societies in the field of economic sciences. His research interests include Input-Output Analysis, issues of economic growth and convergence, structural changes of the agricultural sector and its behavior during economic fluctuations, rural and regional development.
