In this article, we provide a bibliometric analysis that studies the relationship between financial technology (fintech) and regional economic development (RED) research from 2000 to 2025. Building on the Bibliometrix literature database (Biblioshiny), we present a map of how the intellectual architecture, themes, and collaboration patterns among researchers in this interdisciplinary field are developed at various levels, using data from 474 peer-reviewed papers. We assume that the analysis indicates a rapidly growing research field with an annual growth rate of 46.95%, driven in part by increased scholarly inquiry, especially since 2019.

Mapping the Intellectual Structure of Computational Risk Analytics in Banking and Finance: A Bibliometric and Thematic Evolution Study. 2025

Modern financial practices introduce complex risks, which in turn force financial institutions to rely increasingly on computational risk analytics (CRA). The purpose of our research is to systematically explore the evolution and intellectual structure of CRA in banking through a detailed bibliometric analysis of the literature in the Web of Science from 2000 to 2025. A comprehensive search in the Web of Science (WoS) Core Collection yielded 1083 peer-reviewed publications, which we analyzed using analytical tools such as VOSviewer 1.6.20 and Bibliometrix (Biblioshiny 5.0) to examine the dataset and uncover bibliometric characteristics, including citation patterns, keyword occurrences, and thematic clustering. Our initial analysis reveals key research clusters focused on bankruptcy prediction, AI integration in financial services, and advanced deep learning applications. Furthermore, our findings note a transition of CRA from an emerging to an expanding domain, especially after 2019, with terms like machine learning (ML), artificial intelligence (AI), and deep learning (DL) being identified as prominent keywords, and a recent shift towards blockchain, explainability, and financial stability being present. We believe this study addresses the need for an updated mapping of CRA, providing valuable insights for future academic inquiry and practical financial risk management applications.
